Imaginative work-related learning & enterprise training for students

Overview

An imaginative programme designed to help the lower sixth form gel and build good working relationships for the rest of their shared school journey. A fun-packed programme to help reinforce the important life skills – particularly team building, communication and problem-solving. **MORNING:** Positive attitude, B.H.A.G, key qualities for employers, having a dream, feelings & needs, non-verbal communication and the concepts of dependency, independency and interdependency are all covered in a lively introduction. Teams then work competitively on challenges such as 'Mission Impossible', 'Giant Jigsaw', 'Sheep & Shepherds', 'Eco Vehicle' and others, that are both stretching and entertaining. Teams are required to make presentations as part of the judging criteria. **AFTERNOON:** Topics of practical help to students such as time management, learning styles, team roles, personal leadership and memory techniques.

Student Year Groups

All students in years 12 and 13.
(50 to 100 students per session)

Programme Duration & Options

Whole Day. Timings adjusted to fit school timetable. Giant Impact programmes offer flexibility to mix 'n' match programmes to suit individual needs. The modular design allows a half day Team Building & Gelling programme to work particularly well with all other half day modules such as Job Application, Interview & Recruitment, Enterprise, Study for Work, Practical Sales & Marketing and Thinking Efficiency. All programmes can be tailored to meet individual needs. Afternoon session can integrate Year 13 students if required.

Learning Outcomes

The programme gives students the opportunity to meet, work with and get to know better, people in their same year group. Often new friendships are developed and a greater respect engendered for hidden talents from team members. A positive attitude and taking responsibility for personal leadership is encouraged and reinforced, which all help prepare students for the world of work.

School Resources

Assembly/sports hall with small worktables and chairs. Small quantity of stationery. Data projector and screen. Two members of staff to support two experienced presenters.
